Armourcoat Squash Court Cleaning Solution Instruction Leaflet

Introduction

Armourcoat squash court surfaces can be cleaned down with Armourcoat's Cleaning Solution which will have no harmful effect on the topcoat plaster. Other chemical cleaners may damage the plaster. Adequate protection should be provided for wooden squash court floors.

Instructions

- Standard dilution rate : 5% to 10% Cleaning Solution with water. (1:20 to 1:10 Cleaning Solution:Water depending on court condition). The Cleaning Solution can be used at a stronger concentration if required for heavily soiled areas, but the applicator should do a small test patch first.
- Use a wet sponge with clean water to thoroughly dampen down the plaster surface.
- Apply the Cleaning Solution using a lightly abrasive pad or cloth.
- Wipe with a sponge several times to remove the dissolved dirt, abraded plaster and Cleaning Solution.
- There is no Cleaning Solution available that will dissolve graphite marks. These can only be removed by abrasion.
- To clean a squash court it will take two persons approximately six hours and usually 1 x 5 litre container of Cleaning Solution for one court. However a very dirty court may require more.

Health and Safety

Avoid prolonged contact of neat solution with the skin; it is strongly recommended that rubber gloves are worn. If contact with the eyes occurs, flush well with clean water. If accidentally swallowed, seek immediate medical attention. Consult SDS Safety Data Sheet for further information.

Storage

Store in dry conditions between 5°C - 25°C. Protect from frost. Protect from sunlight and sources of direct heat. Keep container sealed when not in use.

Shelf life of Armourcoat Cleaning Solution in unopened container under correct storage conditions is 24 months from date of manufacture.
